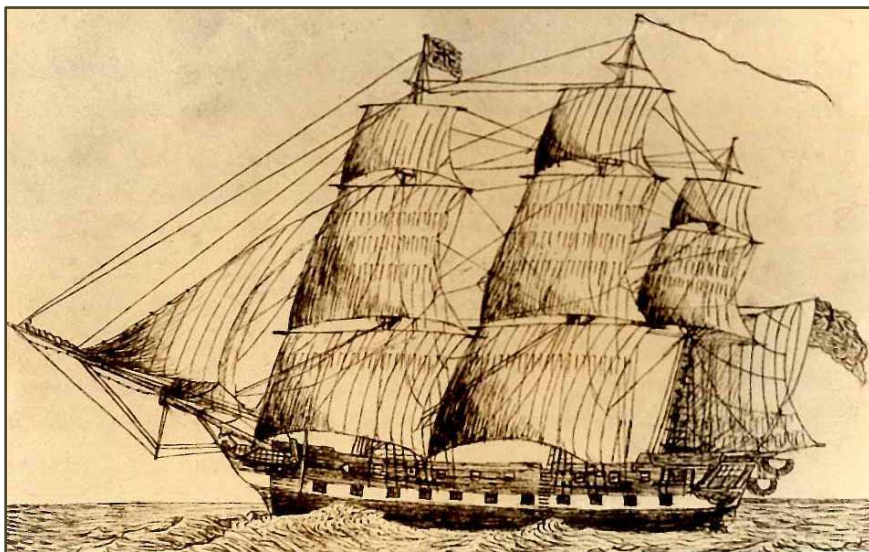

**The Buffalo, Commander J. Wood, sailed yesterday for Canada. On Thursday a detachment of the 51st regt. embarked as a convict guard; also detachments of the 43rd, 1st Grenadier Guards, Coldstream Guards, 1st Dragoon Guards, and the 7th Hussars, to join their respective regiments in Canada. After landing them at Quebec she will take rebel convicts to New South Wales, and then proceed to New Zealand to procure spars and timber for the dock-yard.**
